How do we intend to spend the money?

We have four aims this current academic year.

1. To increase participation in PE throughout the school.

This will be achieved by giving the children a wide range of sport experiences within PE lessons including working with professional coaches in a range of sports including, tennis, gymnastics, football, karate, dance, athletics, rugby and yoga.

In the spring term we will run a change4life club offering the children and families to participate in a healthy lifestyle. As part of this club we will run weekly activities for the children as well as active days out for both children and parents and advice on a healthy life style. We also hope to be able to offer healthy cooking workshops.

We are also taking part in the NUFC's Primary Stars Awards scheme to raise the profile of sport in school.

2. To increase the quality of PE being taught in school.

Staff will have the opportunity to work alongside professional sports coaches teaching blocks of PE lessons. During these blocks teachers will benefit from their expertise. We also have a number of professional coaches delivering afterschool clubs. This includes working with Grassroots for gymnastics and NUFC football.

Staff members will also attend CPD training days including Gateshead School Sports Network meetings and conference and the NUFC Primary Stars Awards and CPD Day.

3. To give children the opportunity to participate of competitive sport and festivals.

We will enter a number of competitions and festivals affiliated by the 'Gateshead School Sport Partnership', 'Blaydon and Winlaton Associated Football.' And NUFC School Sports Football programme.

4. To achieve a Sainsbury's School Sports Mark.

By completing the first 3 points we aim to achieve a Sainsbury School Sportsmark Award as recognition for our efforts and progress in school sports and physical development.

What difference will Sport Premium make to PE and sport participation?

- All children will participate in School Sport Competitions and festivals.
- All children will participate in Intra school competitions. E.g. house matches, competitions in PE lessons, School Games day.
- Afterschool opportunities led by professional coaches.
- Specialist coaching within PE lessons to develop skills of children and class teachers.
- New equipment will be bought to enhance the teaching of Sport within school.

Are these improvements sustainable?

Our aim is to ensure these improvements are sustained in future years.

- Our use of coaches within PE lessons gives the opportunity to upskill teachers.
- Festivals and tournaments are now timetabled across the year to ensure all children have the opportunity to attend at least one Level 2 competition.
- Regular house matches are organised for the whole school to experience Level 1 competitions and use teachers’ expertise.
- More pupils and families within school will have a better knowledge of how to have a healthy life style.
