How did the Sports Premium money impact teaching in the academic year 2015-2016?

Standards in PE are good throughout the school. Planning and lesson show that children have access to a range of different sports and skills. Alongside teacher led lessons children have benefitted from teaching by professional coaches in a variety of sports including Little kickers, Little rugby, Little movers, Tennis, Football, Multi-skills, fencing, karate, basketball and swimming. This has also provided CPD opportunities for teachers.

Teachers follow the LCP scheme of work ensuring continuity and progression across year groups.

We have developed the outside area in both KS1 and KS2 by re-painting ground markings giving the children more opportunity to independent physical activity during playtimes and lunch times as well as enhancing outdoor PE lessons. KS1 are also extending opportunities for physical activity and co-operative play during playtimes by introducing play time equipment such as hula hoops, balls, hurdles, cones and chinks so that children can develop their skills as well as running teacher led games during these times such as rounder's or setting up obstacle course.

KS1 continues to rub 'Wake up-Shake up' every morning from 8:45am to encourage positive healthy life styles.

We are continuing to develop afterschool opportunities for the children. We currently have a KS1 gymnastics club and a KS2 Football club.
