



This week we have celebrated Internet Safety Day.

This year's title has been "Create, Connect and Share Respect a better internet starts with you"

We explain to children that even though we focus on safety during lessons this week we actually are focussed continually and must always be vigilant. The children have completed many activities this week.

Reception read the story Penguinpig and then made up their own creatures to put on the school website to prove that not everything you read on the internet is true.

Year 2 have learnt an E Safety Song, sorted scenarios into things that are nothing to worry about and things that they should talk to a grown up about; designed posters to help other children stay safe and thought about how to say nice things to people online

Year 3 discussed facts about cyber bullying, meeting people offline, blocking people wisely and how to stay safe on the computers both at school and home. They then made internet safety posters on purple mash to go on their display in the ICT suite.

Year 4/5 have been learning all about staying safe on social media. They looked specifically at blocking people wisely, meeting people you've met online, cyber bullying and using social networks appropriately

Year 6 completed a quiz on correct online etiquette.

It has been brought to our attention that some children are able to access inappropriate age related programmes on software such as Netflix. If you have these please remember you can create accounts that are age related which allows you to monitor what the children are watching.
